Message from the Founder Director

2023-2024 was an eventful year. With the support from donor (FCRA funding) during 1st November, 2022 to 31sr October, 2023 ASWB has been able to reach out to many individuals with autism and their families with an unprecedented race. This funding enabled ASWB to start the Outreach program.

Autism Society West Bengal (ASWB) project, PACE, "Parent and Child Empowerment" purpose is to enhance parental skills and provide access to good proven teaching strategies during early intervention for autistic children, especially those newly diagnosed with autism. ASWB had always felt that children with autism from economically challenged homes should also get the benefit of intensive parent training. We had always kept a few seats for the parents from economically challenged families and have offered concessions as per need at ASWB. But as an NGO we could only offer one or at the most two free seats per PACE program, especially the three months Parent & Child Training (PCT).

For the first time in 20 years ASWB has been able to conduct and complete two Free Offline Six Weeks Parent and Child Training (PCT) irrespective of economic capacity. The first free Offline PCT (Started in July, 2023) had 11 children with autism and their parent(s). The second free Offline PCT (Started in September, 2023) had 10 children with autism and their parent(s). The third one started in November, 2023 with 9 parents with their child. With this FCRA funding a total 13 (thirteen) children with autism got free multiple intervention services from ASWB such as Occupational Therapy (OT), speech therapy, one to one intervention, School readiness, and six weeks PCT. Some of the mothers got free psychological counselling at ASWB.

With the increase in our manpower ASWB has been able to do outreach programs like never before. We have been able to spread awareness about overall disabilities and autism in particular in different areas; interact with parents, teachers, community workers; talk about different intervention strategies for autistic children and be able to offer free services to some and at concessional rates to few others. ASWB got the opportunity to associate with different NGOs (non-government organizations), CBOs (Community-based organizations) government and private schools and local governance (panchayat) to spread awareness on Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities in Kolkata, South & North 24 Parganas districts.

We hope in the days to come ASWB fulfills her mission and vision which is providing a supportive, social environment where persons with Autism are understood and their right to participation upheld. The organization strives to enable individuals with Autism and their families to participate in developing strategies to improve their quality of life, optimize their strength through education, advocacy and support.

Message from the Secretary

With the increase in the manpower ASWB was able to do outreach programs like never before in FY 2023 - 2024. ASWB has been able to spread awareness about overall disabilities and autism in particular. ASWB got the opportunity to associate with different NGOs, CBOs, Educational institutions and local governance to spread awareness on Autism

Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities in Kolkata, South & North 24 Parganas districts. ASWB was able to interact with parents, teachers, community workers and talk about different intervention strategies for autistic children and been able to offer free services to some and at concessional rates to few others.

With this additional manpower awareness programs were organized in both government and private schools around Mukundapur after getting the FCRA funds. One of the most prominent work over the years has been our consistent interaction and training with different mainstream schools which enhanced awareness and acceptance. Majority of private schools now believe it is doable and thus giving the students with ASD a chance to enjoy school life.

We could also start Sensitisation about Gender & Sexuality among our staff. So this FCRA grant allowed ASWB to organize a two-day workshop on Gender & Sexuality in end October, 2023. The resource person was the Executive Director of TARSHI, New Delhi, Ms. Prabha Nagaraja. The workshop provided us with much food for thought and we are in the process of revising our POSH Policy.

ASWB signed an agreement with a film director, associated with Doordarshan, to direct a short film regarding the work we are doing. Film shooting has been completed and now sent to the censor board for certification.

We were able to organize awareness programs in institutions of higher learning. The response from faculty as well as from the students of institutions of higher education viz. Department of Nursing, Aliah University; Department of Psychology, Swami Vivekananda University; Department of Education, Adamas University, Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Gurudas College, students of standard XII of the three Narayana group of School during their visit and internship programs at ASWB was very positive. This positive

response has given us the impetus to continue the work on both ends of the society viz.

grassroot level as well as schools and institutions of higher learning. ASWB signed a MoU with

Swami Vivekananda University (SVU). Seven students of the Department of Psychology, SVU did

a one month internship at ASWB. Like all years there were interactive sessions between

students/trainees with autism of our Dikshan & Aarohan units with the undergraduate students

of the Department of Nursing, Aliah University who visited ASWB. Students of the Department

of education, Adamas University also visited ASWB and saw the teaching methods for our

students with autism.

ASWB has always encouraged self-advocacy and conceptualized workshops in collaboration with

the State Government during the World Autism Awareness Day (WAAD) programs in April,

2023. In August 2023, a one day seminar was organized in collaboration with the renowned

institution of national importance like Asiatic Society. There some autistic individuals

(self-advocates) shared their thoughts and perspectives using different means of

communication.

So in 2023-2024 ASWB has spread awareness among autism at two ends of the society viz, at

the grassroots level in the rural areas of 24 Parganas (South) and also in centers of higher

learning, We hope to continue this trend in the years to come.
